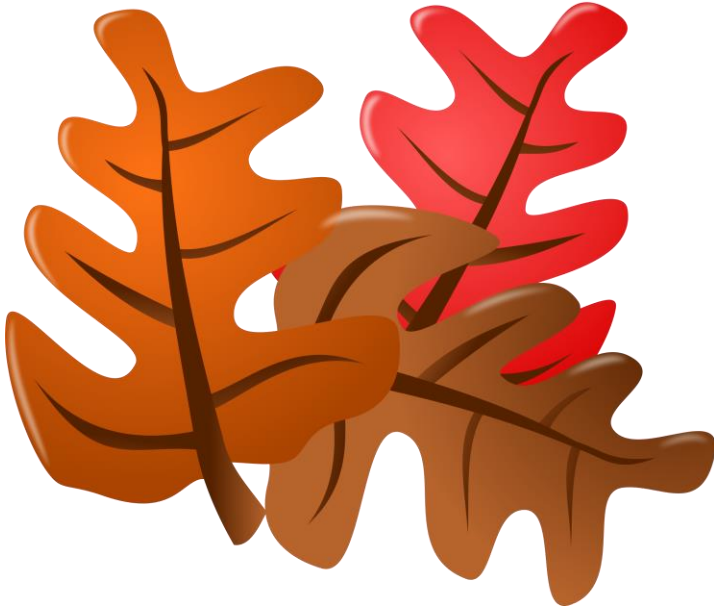
Psalm 34:8 encourages us with these two senses: "Taste & see that the LORD is good; blessed is the one who takes refuge in him."

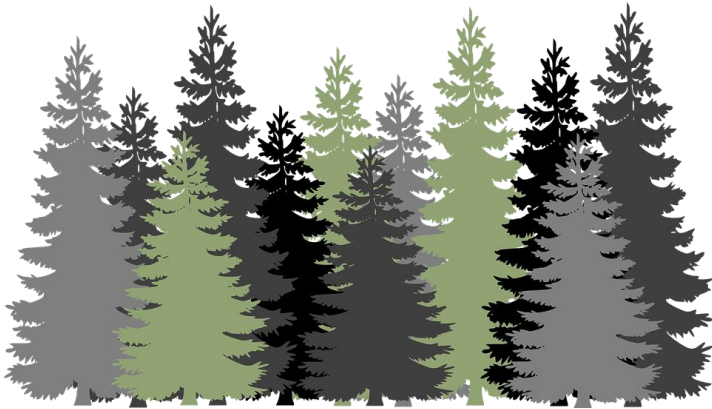
